

UNIVERSITY OF LOUISVILLE/FORD-EEOC ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

BRIEF DESCRIPTION:

This scholarship is awarded to minorities or women, who have a connection to Ford Motor Company as an employee, their spouse or child and are a resident of the Commonwealth of Kentucky. For entering freshmen, a high school of 3.0 GPA or above and a composite ACT score of 20 or above is required. For continuing University of Louisville students, a cumulative college GPA of 2.5 or above is required. Transfer, non-traditional, post-baccalaureate and graduate level students must have comparable proof of academic merit.

SCHOLARSHIP AMOUNT:

The amount depends on how many qualified applicants the University has each year and funds available to award.
