BRIEF DESCRIPTION:

In 1983, Ford Motor Company entered into a Conciliation Agreement resolving the Equal Employment Opportunity Commission's (EEOC's) 1973 charge of discrimination against Ford Motor Company and the United Automobile Workers. The provision of the Agreement endowed specified colleges and universities with funds to be used to provide scholarships in perpetuity for minority and female employees of Ford Motor Company and their eligible spouses and offspring. Under Ford Motor Company's Educational Endowment and Grants Program, scholarship funds are made available annually to meet their designated purpose.
