BRIEF DESCRIPTION:

The Ford Motor Company (Ford) Equal Employment Opportunity Commission (EEOC) Endowed Scholarship Program supports undergraduate students enrolled at Cal Poly, with preference to Ford Motor Company employees, their spouses and children. In May, Cal Poly posts additional information on its website for students to self-identify themselves and how to communicate that information to the Financial Aid Office.

SCHOLARSHIP AMOUNT:

The amount of the Scholarship varies, depending upon funding availability – typically ranges from \$1,500 to \$3,000; Scholarship is renewable, based on academic performance and funding availability.

APPLICATION DEADLINE:

Students interested in the Ford-EEOC Scholarship should email the Assistant Director of Financial Aid and Scholarships between May and August. Communication received later will be considered, depending upon funding availability.
