BRIEF DESCRIPTION:

Northwestern University meets the full demonstrated need for students, who qualify for financial aid. Eligibility for financial aid is determined by the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), the Profile and tax information. A complete financial aid application is necessary for a student to be considered for financial aid. Student must qualify and receive need-based aid and must have at least a 3.0 GPA.

SCHOLARSHIP AMOUNT:

The Ford-EEOC Scholarship is dependent upon the number of applicants.

APPLICATION DEADLINE:

There is not a separate application or specific deadline date. Eligible students receiving need-based aid will be considered for the Scholarship during the academic year.
